History of the Elantra

- First introduced in 1992, Elantra has always been a strong competitor in the compact sedan market.
- Major restyles have been in 1996 and 2001.
- 2002 saw the introduction of the popular GT 5-door hatchback model with sportier performance and handling.
- The fourth-generation platform introduced as a 2004 model was significantly updated with an all-new look both front and rear, featuring new grille, bumpers, headlights and taillights.
 - The engine was updated with CVT (Continuously Variable Valve Timing) to help reduce emissions and an OCS (Occupant Classification System) was added to the front-passenger airbag to indicate if the front-passenger airbag had been deactivated.
 - Inside, was a standard Kenwood AM/FM/CD/MP3 stereo, the first MP3 capable stereo in any Hyundai vehicle.
 - A GT trim was added to the 4-door sedan model, so the 4-door sedan was available in both GLS and GT trims, while the 5-door hatchback models was only available in a GT trim.
- In 2005, a GLS trim was added to the 5-door hatchback model, making both the 4-door sedans and 5-door hatchbacks available in either GLS or GT trims.
- For 2006, Elantra adds the “Limited” trim level, joining the GLS and GT trims:
 - Limited models are fully equipped luxury models for buyers desiring sophisticated styling and leather seating.
 - Standard on Elantra are popular equipment features like cruise control and AM/FM/CD audio system with six speakers.
 - A Premium Package is added which combines power sunroof, Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) and Traction Control System (TCS).
 - The 4-door GT model has been discontinued.
