History of the Tucson

Introduced during the fall of 2004 as a 2005 model, Tucson competes in the very popular compact SUV market. Tucson styling has a masculine, athletic appearance and delivers lots of utility. It's designed to be a versatile companion to the buyer's lifestyle and to provide the best value in the marketplace in equipment, style, image and value.

Tucson features a spacious, well-configured interior that provides room and comfort for the driver and passengers and all their cargo. It also provides a large, versatile and durable cargo area with fold-flat rear seats and folding front-passenger seat. The front-passenger seat can be folded forward to provide extra storage room or a workspace for the driver. It can also be fully reclined as a seat. The rear mat is removable and exposes a durable, easy-to-clean plastic floor with multiple tie-down locations for everyone's gear.

Tucson is equipped with a total of six airbags—driver and passenger advanced front airbags, driver and passenger seat-mounted side-impact airbags, and roof-mounted side-curtain airbags for both front- and rear-seat occupants.

Tucson buyers can select from two engines. The GL model features Hyundai's proven 2.0-liter DOHC 4-cylinder engine fitted with Continuously Variable Valve Timing (CVVT) matched to a 5-speed manual transmission or available SHIFTRONIC® automatic transmission. Hyundai's 2.7-liter DOHC V6 is standard on the GLS and Limited models and is matched to the SHIFTRONIC® automatic transmission. The 2.7-liter V6 as used in Tucson is fitted with a variable-length, tuned intake system for smoother delivery of power across the entire rev band. 4-wheel drive is available with either engine.

Tucson uses the state-of-the-art Borg-Warner Electronic InterActive Torque Management 4-wheel-drive system that routes up to 99% of the available power to the front wheels. As road conditions or torque demand changes, the system automatically diverts up to 50% of the available power to the rear wheels. The system monitors throttle position, front wheel angle and slippage.

As surface conditions change, power is automatically routed to the wheels with the best traction. There is also a dashboard-mounted 4WD lock button that allows the driver to manually "lock" the driveline into 4-wheel drive for a 50/50 torque split.

Standard features on Tucson include 4-wheel disc brakes, 16-inch alloy wheels, air conditioning, power windows and door locks, seat-mounted side-impact airbags for the driver and front-seat passenger, side-impact protection (side-curtain airbags) for the front- and rear-seat passengers, and remote keyless entry alarm system. Additional standard features include heated outside rearview mirrors, front windshield de-icer (V6 only), rear privacy glass, roof rack side rails, rear intermittent wiper, Tire Pressure Monitoring System (V6 only), and an AM/FM/CD stereo system with six speakers.

Available features include leather seating surfaces, and Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) with Traction Control System (TCS). A power sunroof with tilt is also available along with front-seat warmers, fog lights, remote keyless entry with alarm, AM/FM/Cassette/CD/MP3 with six speakers (standard on GLS), AM/FM/Cassette with in-dash 6-disc CD changer, six speakers and woofer (standard on Limited) and roof rack cross rails.

- *SmartMoney* magazine named the Hyundai Tucson "The Best Value Car Award Winner" in the small SUV category ahead of rivals like the Toyota RAV-4 and Honda CR-V. Standard features on the Tucson, such as front and rear-passenger airbags, exterior styling and Hyundai's "unusually good warranty" were all contributing factors to Tucson's win, according to the magazine's October issue.
- 2006 Hyundai Tucson has received the U.S. National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) top five-star crash test rating for front and side impacts.

New for 2006

A new Limited trim level replaces the LX trim.

Limited trim includes all GLS features plus:

- Leather seating surfaces
- Heated front seats
- AM/FM/cassette with in-dash 6-disc CD changer and subwoofer
- Monochromatic exterior with body-color cladding
- Automatic temperature control with Air Quality System (AQS) and outside temperature display
- Electrochromatic mirror with compass
- Carpeted rear cargo mat

- A trip computer is standard on GLS and Limited trims.
- A Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) is standard on GLS and Limited trims.

¹ NHTSA studies show passenger cars equipped with Electronic Stability Control (ESC) experienced 35% fewer single-vehicle crashes and 30% fewer single-vehicle fatalities. In a similar study conducted by the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS), ESC reduced fatal single-vehicle crash risk by about 56%. ESC also reduced the risk of all single-vehicle crashes (fatal and non-fatal) by 41%.

² NHTSA crash test results are ranked from 1 to 5 stars, with 5 stars being the best. 5 stars = 10% or less chance of serious injury, 4 stars = 11% to 20% chance of serious injury, 3 stars = 21% to 35% chance of serious injury, 2 stars = 36% to 45% chance of serious injury, 1 star = 46% or greater chance of serious injury

◆ Interactive Torque Management 4-Wheel-Drive System

Tucson 4-wheel-drive models come with an electronic InterActive Torque Management 4-wheel-drive system that is similar to the system that was first introduced on the Santa Fe 3.5-liter.

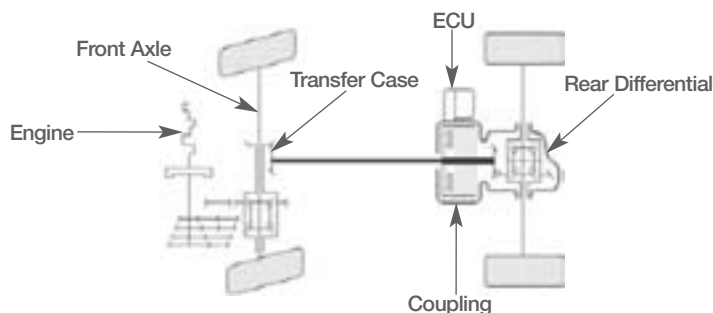
Tucson's Electronic InterActive Torque Management 4-wheel-drive system routes up to 99% of the power to the front wheels: as road conditions or torque demand (acceleration) changes, the system automatically diverts up to 50% of the power to the rear wheels. This electronic "on demand" system operates by monitoring the throttle position, front wheel angle and wheel slippage; then, as conditions change, power is automatically routed to the wheels with the best traction.

Dash-Mounted 4WD Lock Button



The system is technically identical to the 3.5-liter 4-wheel-drive system on Santa Fe **EXCEPT the Tucson system can be manually "locked" into 4-wheel drive for a continuous 50/50 power split between the front and rear wheels for off-road and very slippery applications.** The 4WD lock will begin to disengage at 20 mph and will be fully disengaged at speeds over 25 mph. The system will begin to re-lock when speeds are below 25 mph. The system is disabled when the Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) is activated:

- Under acceleration, this system senses when the front wheels start to spin, then sends more power to the rear wheels for balanced acceleration.
- When going around a corner, the weight of the vehicle shifts, which can affect traction. With this system, power is automatically transferred to the wheels with the best grip.
- When driving on loose terrain, this system maintains balance for traction.

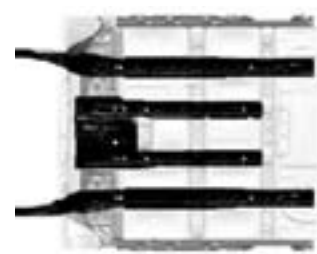
The 2006 Tucson is one of the best-equipped vehicles in its class when it comes to standard safety features. All this is standard:

- **Front Airbags**—Driver and front-passenger with front-passenger Occupant Classification System
- **Seat-Mounted Side-Impact Airbags**—Driver and front-passenger seats
- **Front and Rear Roof-Mounted Side-Curtain Airbags**—Positioned from the front through the rear-passenger area, across the side windows
- **Front Seatbelts**—3-point with ELR (ELR/ ALR on passenger seatbelt) and adjustable shoulder belt height, belt and buckle pretensioners and load limiters
- **Rear Seatbelts**—3-point ELR/ALR, all positions
- **Rear Seat**—LATCH Lower Anchors and Tethers for Children (2)
- **Child-Seat Tether Anchors (3)**—Mounted in cargo floor
- **Child-Proof Rear Door Locks**
- **Reinforced 4-Ring Structure**—Wraps around passenger compartment for added strength.
- **Reinforced 4-Way Member Structure**—Adds strength and rigidity to chassis to help channel the force of an accident away from the passenger compartment.
- **Reinforced High-Tensile Steel Sub-Frame**—Cradles the engine, providing additional strength.
- **Additional Reinforcement Measures**—Include a front “crush zone” to absorb the energy of an impact, optimized side-impact door beams, reinforced dash side members, and one-piece side outer door reinforcement.
- **4-Wheel Disc Brakes**—Electronic Stability Control (ESC) is standard on all models, as is Traction Control System (TCS) and Anti-lock Braking System (ABS).

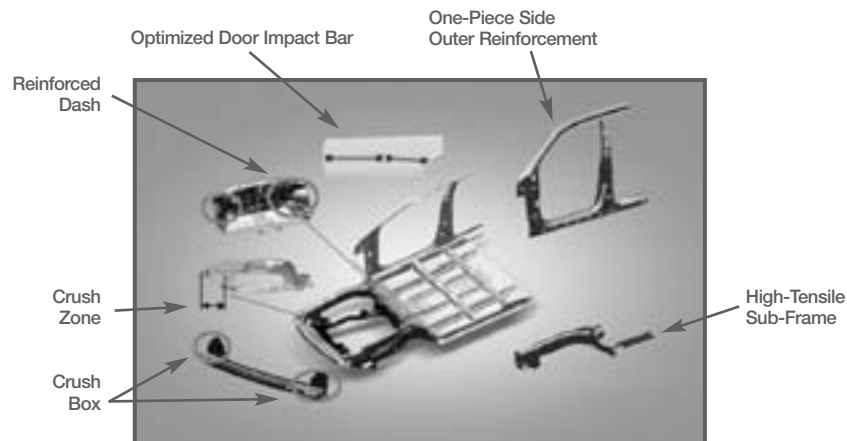
4-Ring Structure



4-Way Member Structure



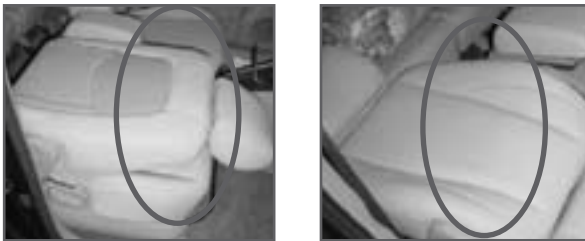
