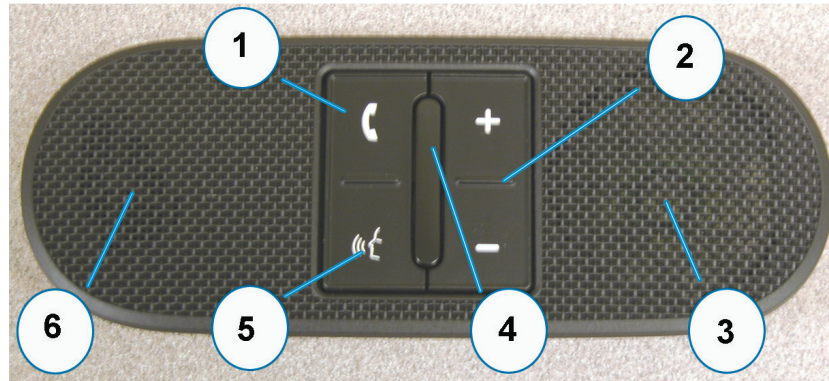


Port or Dealer Installed Bluetooth

1. Phone Button or Activation/Deactivation Button

- Push to set up and program unit
- Push to make a call if not on a call
- Push to end a call
- Push to accept or reject an incoming call when on another call

2. Volume Up & Down Buttons

- Push (+) to Increase the volume
- Push (-) to decrease the volume
- Push either button to the desired volume level when the unit is not activated. Audible beeps indicate the current volume level

3. Speaker

4. Blue L.E.D. Light

- A blue light comes on indicating that the unit is activated or when there is an incoming call. It also comes on when you are on a call

5. VR (Voice Recognition) Button or Barge - In Button

- Push to input a command without having to listen for a prompt
- Push to transfer a call. This allows you to transfer your call back to your cell phone in the event you want privacy or are exiting the vehicle
- Push to mute the phone

6. Directional Microphone

Frequently Asked Questions

Are all Bluetooth® phones compatible with the BlueConnect® system?

No, the BlueConnect system is only compatible with Bluetooth handsfree profiled phones and that have passed our testing standards. Please check the compatibility list by visiting www.jciblueconnect.com or call 1-888-528-7930.

Please note: Mobile phone security systems vary. Additional connectivity steps may be necessary for use with the Bluetooth system.

BlueConnect's main menu lists the following voice prompts:

- "CALL" - "REDIAL" - "CANCEL" to exit
- "DIAL" - "EMERGENCY"
- "PHONEBOOK" - "SET UP"

1. How do I pair my phone?

Follow the steps below to connect your Bluetooth handsfree profiled cell phone to BlueConnect.

- Press the Phone button
- Then say "SET UP"
- Say "PHONE PAIRING"
- Say "PAIR A PHONE"
- Say "CONTINUE"
- Please make sure the car is in park.....
Enter a 4 digit pin code, ex. (1, 2, 3, 4)
- Start pairing to your handsfree Bluetooth phone and select the same pin code on your phone as you did for BlueConnect. (Make sure your Bluetooth is "ON" on your handset before pairing)
- Once pairing is complete BlueConnect will ask what priority you would like your phone, pick priority 1 thru 7
- Pairing complete

2. How do I dial a number?

- Press the Phone button
- Then say "DIAL"
- BlueConnect will say "Number Please", say your 7-10 digit number (without any pauses, ex. 6163948888)

3. How do I add a phonebook entry?

- Press the Phone button
- Then say "PHONEBOOK"
- Say "NEW ENTRY"
- Follow the prompts to complete the entry

4. How do I call someone from my phonebook?

- Press the Phone button
- Then say "CALL"
- Then say a name from your phonebook entry

5. How do I receive an incoming call?

- Press the Phone button to receive the call

6. How do I transfer a call to my handset?

- Press and release the VR/Barge Button during a call and say, "TRANSFER CALL"
- The call will transfer to your handset and you can continue your call

7. I am having difficulty making the BlueConnect understand me.

The BlueConnect voice recognition is designed to interpret commands from the driver's seat, spoken at a normal rate, at a normal volume level.

Please use the following tips when speaking to it:

- Speak at a normal volume, looking straight through the windshield
- Speak at a normal pace without pauses
- Wait for the beep to sound before giving the unit a command
- Reduce other sounds in the vehicle
(ex. passengers talking, wind noise, radio, climate control, etc.)

8. I am having difficulty navigating through the menus.

In any menu at any given time, saying "HELP" will list the available commands for that menu. Similarly, saying "CANCEL" will navigate back through the menus to the main menu, and finally to standby mode.
